Minnesota Beehives

Bees pollinate more than 130 varieties of fruits and vegetables around the globe — a third of our food supply. As a part of our environmental, social and governance initiatives, Altus has partnered with Alveole to bring bees to our properties in Minnesota.

We are proud to be a leader for eco-conscious cities through hive installation. Our hives, located in green space and on the roofs of our properties, host thousands of bees and pollinate the surrounding urban flora throughout the summer. At the end of the season, the beekeepers will har-vest the honey which we will share with our building communities.



Our project is realized in collaboration with Alvéole, a social beekeeping company. Since 2013, Alvéole has partnered with hundreds of companies and schools to start beekeeping projects all over North America and Europe, each hive creating more ecological awareness, allowing city dwellers to reconnect with nature and change their sense of responsibility towards the environment.

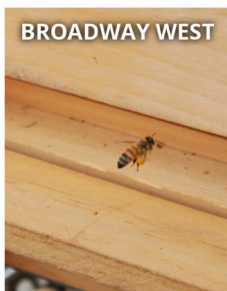
